The rol of G.L.A.R in Romania

In Romania, the governmental strategy, adopted (430/2001) it is a model of Roma participation in the development of the policy, in partnership with governmental institutions.

<u>G.L.A..R</u> -The working Group was established at the convening of the General meeting of Roma civil and political association in Mangalia and Sibiu (January – February 1999). GLAR had mandate from the general meeting of the Roma civil and political associations to analyse the situation and develop a strategy for an action plan regarding Roma people from Romania..This document represent the Roma contribution to the reform of public institutions and the elaboration of governmental policies for Roma..

At present 2009

Different actors, both governmental and non-governmental are trying to play a role in the process of the implementing the strategy for Roma.

In health domain. Civil society collaborate with Ministry of Health:

- 500 health mediators
- 600 doctors MD trained by the Roma trainers
- 1 councilor for Roma Ministry of Health
- National Agency for Roma under General Secretariat of Government of Romania collaborate directly with Ministry of Public Health
